ENVIRONMENTAL LAW SUMMER INTERNSHIP CONNECTICUT FUND FOR THE ENVIRONMENT AND SAVE THE SOUND

Connecticut Fund for the Environment (“CFE”) and its bi-state program Save the Sound are accepting applications for law student internships in the New Haven Office for summer 2020.

CFE is a non-profit environmental organization with over 4,000 members region-wide. CFE’s mission is to protect and improve the land, air and water of Connecticut and Long Island Sound. The Save the Sound Program is dedicated to the protection, preservation and appreciation of Long Island Sound. We use law and other tools to defend, protect and improve the land, air and water of Connecticut and Long Island Sound.

CFE/Save the Sound has an active docket of federal and state court and administrative cases and three attorneys on staff. We also have a full legislative agenda relating to climate, lands and water. Senior Legal Counsel founded and runs the UConn Law School Environmental Law Clinic during the academic year and oversees the internship program throughout the summer. Throughout its history CFE/Save the Sound has:

- **Taken polluters to court — and won,**
- Intervened in permit processes to reduce or eliminate destruction or pollution of natural resources to preserve thousands of acres of pristine open space,
- Battled special interests seeking to undermine environmental protections, and
- Worked with coalitions to fight for climate change regulation, clean water and open space.

The position is ideal for law students seeking experience in public interest environmental law and advocacy. The internship will involve legal writing and advocacy for cases pending before agencies and state and federal courts, as well as policy research. The candidate should have an outstanding academic record, strong communications skills and demonstrated writing ability.
